



As of September 1st, 2021, the Milwaukee Area Youth Hockey Association submitted to WAHA Region 5 Directors the intent of dissolution.

The Region 5 Associations bordering the aforementioned MYHA met November 10th, 2021 at the Pettit National Ice Center to negotiate the redistricting of the MYHA boundaries and current players.

In attendance were representatives of Waukesha Youth Hockey, Southeast Hockey Association of Wisconsin, Elmbrook Youth Hockey, Arrowhead Youth Hockey, Region 5 Directors Robin Bilsborough, Rich Gray and Tim Pickart, and Region 5 Registrar Tom Slocum. Absent was Winter Club Hockey.

The following redistricting was agreed upon by Associations in attendance for approval of Region 5.

The Milwaukee Area Youth Hockey Associations territory was divided between SHAW, Elmbrook, Waukesha and Winter Club.

The players who were previously registered with MAYHA and sought a new home for 2021 were granted two options.

1. The association they joined for the 2021-22 season would be considered their new "Home Association" for the remainder of their youth hockey tenure, regardless if their current residence was redistricted to another Association. Siblings of current players would also be "Grandfathered" to the Association of registration of the 2021-22 season if desired, to enable a family to stay within the same rink.
2. If their current residence was redistricted to an Association other than the one they registered with in 2021-22 and they wished to switch to the new residency designated association for 2022-23, they could do so with no requirement of transfer waivers. This would become their "Home Association" in perpetuity.

WAHA Region 5 Associations meeting, held January 26th, 2022, had all Association's in attendance vote unanimously for the above listed resolutions to address the dissolution of Milwaukee Area Youth Hockey Association.
