Re: 2021 USA Hockey Central District High Performance 14 Player Development Camp

Congratulations! Based on your performance and ratings at your recent Affiliate Player Evaluation Tryouts, you have been selected as one of the top 2007 players from USA Hockey Central District States and you are invited to attend this district camp to be held at Iowa State University in Ames, IA on June 13-18, 2021.

The camp program is specifically designed for the experienced and highly motivated hockey player. Therefore, it is highly recommended that the players be in top physical condition when arriving at this camp. You will experience Intensive on-ice instruction designed to improve player skills as well as team skills. Practice and games are included with specialized off-ice classroom sessions.

The coaching staff will be directed by Iowa State's legendary Head Coach, Dr. Al Murdoch along with other coaches from diverse backgrounds. Players will be evaluated by the USA Hockey National Office Player Development/Coaching Staff and evaluations will be kept for future national camp considerations.

Approximately 102 players at the 2007 birth-year from Illinois, Wisconsin, Missouri, Iowa, Kansas and Nebraska will attend. The players are assigned to one of six teams for an intense week of skill development which includes a mini round robin camp tournament for the players.

This USAH Central District Camp will also include up and coming on-ice officials. These officials will be participating in their own intense skill development camp while working camp games.

The cost for the Central District 14 Development Camp is **\$700.00** per player. The cost of the camp has remained low for many years because grants and fundraisers have covered the increases. Please remember that player families that have to decline this camp must contact me at mike.connor@wahahockey.com as soon as possible. Please go to www.centraldistricthockey.org then Player Development then “Boys” home page to find your affiliate state, your birth-year (2007), your name, and position then click your name and follow the instructions and complete your camp registration and payment ASAP.

You must complete a mandatory Consent to Treat Form. You will find a blank form posted on the Central District website. Please complete the form and return to tom.slocum@wahahockey.com no later than Friday April 9h. Please note that returning your Consent to Treat Form by April 9th, registering and paying your Camp Fee by May 1st confirms your commitment and roster spot in this camp. If we do not receive those items, we will assume you are dropping from this camp. It is an honor and a great opportunity to be identified by USA Hockey and invited to this camp. We sincerely hope that no player has to decline this camp. If you are unable to attend for any reason, please contact us as soon as possible to allow another player to take this opportunity.

Players will reside on campus and meals will be provided by the Iowa State University. Please note that campers will not be allowed to wear hats inside the cafeteria. Please leave large sums of money or valuable jewelry at home. The weather in Ames, IA is about the same as in Chicago, St. Louis, Des Moines and Milwaukee. Players will be required to bring the following: necessary hockey equipment, spare sticks, comfortable clothing for the "off-ice" activities, appropriate shoes, a pillow, linen, towels and toiletries.

Moms and Dads should ask their player to call them regularly to let them know how the camp is going. Parents are welcome to visit the University Arena for practices and games but are not allowed at the dorms. Players may not at any time leave with their parents until the camp concludes on Friday June 18.

There will be an adult 'team leader/counselor' with each team 24 hours a day. On or before June 7, watch for a Select 14 Handbook and Camp Rosters and the full Schedule to be posted on the Central District Website (www.centraldistricthockey.org). There will also be brief instructions as to camp arrival on Sunday and departure on Friday.
