MITE EQUIPMENT GRANT PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association (WAHA) is continuing to support the growth of hockey by providing this **GRANT PROGRAM** for the third year to help our community based hockey associations with providing equipment for their Learn to Play and/or Mini Mite Programs. The program will award 10 sets of mite equipment each to 6 associations in each region. Each set of equipment includes a stick, jersey, helmet, neck laceration guard, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, jockey shorts with cup, breezers, shin pads and socks valued at \$350.

All WAHA hockey associations that offer Learn to Play Programs are eligible to apply by completing the application form. Associations awarded grants must agree to attend the WAHA workshops and attend the WAHA Annual Meeting at the Holiday Inn in Stevens Point on August 3, 2024. If associations don't attend the grant will be awarded to another association that attended the event.

The application deadline is July 1, 2024.
